

**TUE, OCT 29 – TOULON (PROVENCE)**

Arrive in Toulon, situated in Southern France on the Mediterranean Coast. Explore the charming old town with its small squares, fountains, quaint shops and cafes. Optional excursions include visits to St. Tropez, Marseille, Aix en Provence and other coastal towns and hilltop villages. (B,L,D)

**WED, OCT 30 – BARCELONA**

**TUE, NOV 5 – NAPLES**
